THE SIM International Academy (SIM IA) is turning the conventional education approach for most students on its head.

Instead of taking the O- and A-level route, after primary school, students can take SIM IA's direct pathway to pursue a Cambridge International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), followed by an International A Level certification.

Foreigners are eligible for IGCSE programme admission, while Singaporean students need approval from the Ministry of Education. They are eligible for the International A Level programme.
